

Statement of Ethics and Good Practice

The editorial team of the *Neumología Pediátrica* de la Sociedad Chilena de Pediatría journal takes as reference the Code of Conduct and Good Practices that the Committee on Publication Ethics (COPE) defines for editors of scientific journals. With this objective, compliance with the following points is promoted:

Articles corresponding to medical research must comply with the "*Declaration of Helsinki*". They must have the approval of the corresponding ethics committee and informed consent and assent as deemed appropriate.

Articles will be evaluated by anonymous external peers.

The authors of the works must comply with the internationally established requirements on authorship policy.

Each article should be published with the conflicts of interest statement of the authors.

Authors must ensure that the articles and materials associated with them are original and do not infringe copyright.

The authors must also justify that, in the case of a shared authorship, there was a full consensus of all the affected authors and that the proposed article has not been presented or published previously in another media source.

Total or partial plagiarism, redundant or fractional publication, manipulation or falsification of data from a manuscript will be eliminated from the evaluation process.

Upon discovering a transgression, an investigation will be requested by the sponsor or institution to which the authors belong. If the work has not yet been published, the editorial process will be suspended until receiving the ruling report from the institution involved.
